Disposed of pursuant to the Agreement and Plan of Merger and Reorganization dated as of December 1, 2014 (the "Merger Agreement" and, the transactions contemplated therein, the "Merger"), by and among Cypress Semiconductor Corporation ("Cypress"), Mustang
(1) Acquisition Corporation (a wholly owned subsidiary of Cypress) and Issuer, whereby each share of Issuer common stock was canceled and automatically converted into 2.457 shares of Cypress common stock (the "Exchange Ratio"), with fractional shares being paid in cash as provided in the Merger Agreement.
