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Item 5.02 Departure of Directors or Principal Officers; Election of Directors; Appointment of Principal Officers

On July 11, 2006, David Mitchell, Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of Macquarie Infrastructure Company (the Company), resigned from his position to spend more time with his family and to pursue other interests. He will remain as CFO through the publication of the Company 's financial results for the second quarter of 2006 on August 9, 2006 and his resignation will be effective August 31, 2006.

The Company is engaged in an external search for a permanent successor to Mr. Mitchell. In the event that the search effort does not result in the appointment of a permanent CFO prior to the effective date of Mr. Mitchell 's resignation, Todd Weintraub, age 43, will be appointed as interim Chief Financial Officer, effective August 31, 2006.

Mr. Weintraub joined the Macquarie Group in May 2005 acting as Vice President of Finance, reporting to Mr. Mitchell. Prior to joining Macquarie he was the Director of Accounting at Pathmark Foods.
