Item 5. Other Events.

On December 10, 2002, American Tower Corporation (the "Company") announced the signing of a definitive agreement with NII Holdings, Inc. to acquire 535 communication towers in Mexico for an aggregate purchase price of \$100 million. The Company has also agreed to provide up to 250 additional cell sites to NII Holdings' incremental network build-out, of which at least 100 cell sites must be co-locations on the Company's existing towers. The remaining 150 cell sites, if not co-located on the Company's existing towers, will be part of a build-to-suit program, which the Company expects to be completed over the next three years. The NII Holdings transaction is expected to close in stages, with the first closing of approximately \$30 million scheduled to close by the end of 2002 and the remaining \$70 million expected to close by the end of the second quarter 2003, subject to customary closing conditions. The Company expects to fund the closings with proceeds from consummated and planned non-core asset sales.
