In either occurrence, (i) or (ii), the RSUs automatically convert into shares of common stock on a one-for-one basis at no conversion cost to the Reporting Person.

The RSUs are issued in whole units at a 33% discount from fair market value of the issuer's common stock on the date the underlying bonus is determined and generally vest 3 years from the date of the grant, at which time the RSUs convert into shares of common stock on a one-for-one basis unless the executive previously elected a longer deferral period.
- (3) The options generally vest in equal annual installments of one-third of the original stock option grant over a three year period from award date. The options convert into shares of common stock on a one-for-one basis.
