The new program is the result of the anticipated early completion of the May 2006 repurchase program. A total of 320,852 shares have been purchased under the May 2006 stock

repurchase program, at an average cost of \$30.07 per share, leaving 29,706 shares available for future purchases.

Under the January 2007 program, shares will be purchased from time to time in the open market or privately negotiated transactions over a one-year period (once the May 2006 program has been completed) depending on market conditions and the capital requirements of the Corporation.

ANNOUNCES 5% STOCK REPURCHASE PROGRAM

Riverside, Calif. - January 23, 2007 - Provident Financial Holdings, Inc. ("Company"), NASDAQ GSM: PROV, the holding company for Provident Savings Bank, F.S.B., today announced that its Board of Directors authorized the repurchase of up to 5% of its common stock (approximately 333,365 shares). The new program is the result of the anticipated early completion of the May 2006 stock repurchase program. A total of 320,852 shares have been purchased under the May 2006 stock repurchase program, at an average cost of \$30.07 per share, leaving 29,706 shares available for future purchases.

Under the January 2007 program, shares will be purchased from time to time in the open market or privately negotiated transactions over a one-year period (once the May 2006 program has been completed) depending on market conditions and the capital requirements of the Company. This repurchase program represents the 13th buyback program through which the Company has previously purchased approximately 5.59 million shares.
